Pay As You Throw (PAYT) Subscription Fee

November 1, 2018 - October 31, 2019

Middletown's annual user fee for the trash and recycling program is \$141 and the cost of the PAYT bags are \$1.75 per 15-gallon bag, \$2 per 33-gallon bag, \$1 per 8-gallon bag.

The \$141 annual user fee entitles residents to curbside trash, recycling, seasonal yard waste and Christmas tree collection, four annual Bulk Waste Amnesty Days, and notification of local Eco-Depots as well as other events.

Upon receipt of your completed application, the Town will mail you a set of stickers to affix to your carts to indicate that your household participates in the Town's trash and recycling program. Refuse, recycling and yard waste (including Christmas trees) will only be collected from households who pay the user fee.

Payment must be received by October 31st in order for there to be no interruption of service. In addition to mailing this application to Town Hall, you may also purchase stickers at the Department of Public Works Offices (9 Berkeley Ave, Middletown) Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.
